Low interest rates and an increasing feeling of confidence is giving the housing and general investment market a real boost. A good Spring also has the benefit of generating stock shortages which clears out the old and tired stock. The buying public gets a sense of urgency and desire as plants sell out. We now need to have a mildish Summer with few fires and a long Autumn. We are seeing some clouds with the loss of jobs in some of the bigger industries but it will still only take our unemployment up to, maybe 6%. At this level there will still be many areas where it is hard to get staff and very hard to get good staff. The slight rise is also beneficial in that it helps reduce any push for wage increases or changes to benefits like penalty rates. Hopefully the new Abbott government will address the crazy levels of penalty and weekend rates. Unfortunately, our industry doesn't seem to be lobbying for changes. The hospitality sector is and if they are successful we should be able to get some positive movements. One of the annoying things in modern Society is the rise of what I call the...

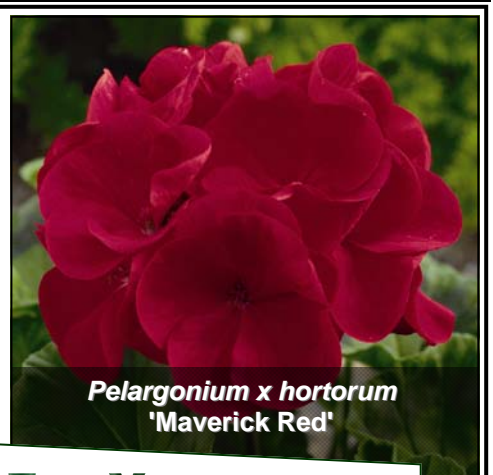

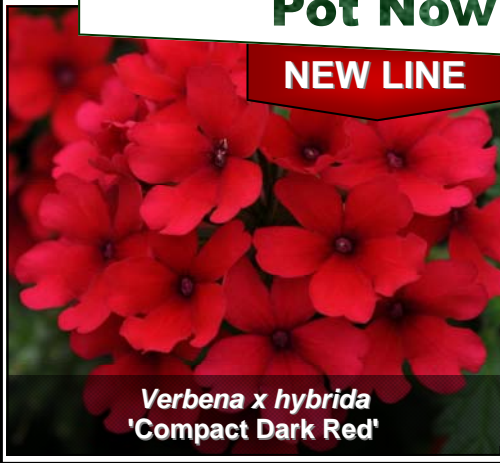
